Now is a good time to sit a mock test. This helps expose children to the reality of the test, allows them to make mistakes to learn from, gives experience of working under time pressure and identifies areas to address.

- Monitored tests with multiple choice questions and online answer sheet.
- Responses automatically emailed upon submission
- Papers marked then a written report with scores and ranking provided.
