Key dates:

- 1st April: Registration opens – register your child to take the test/s
- 6th June: Registration closes – if your child needs additional support, you MUST get a letter of Support from your school by this date.
- 27th June: Venue notification – parents are advised which school their child will take the test.
- 6th Sept: Academic test - VR & Maths -Morning or Afternoon
- 8th Sept: Music test
- 10th Sept: Sports test.
